Course Introduction

Learning the basics of boat operation and safety is best done before your first trip to the mariner or launch ramp. In fact NMSA requires boat operators to take a boating education/awareness course and carry a license or certificate proving that one has successfully completed a course on small craft awareness programme.

Participating in this course will teach how to properly operate and maintain a boat - Responsibilities and Personal Safety will also be covered. Passage of final exam is also another requirement.

Objective

The objectives of this course are to provide the basic knowledge and skills necessary to handle small boats and also to use safety equipment safely and correctly.
